

Mindia Devi Klein is a bansuri and jazz flutist, award winning composer, educator and multi-instrumentalist who has earned a reputation as one of the pioneers of World Music. Born in Brooklyn, NY, she trained first in classical music, then jazz and by age 19 followed her muse to India and Indonesia. A disciple of Ustad Ali Akbar Khan, her root guru, she studied bansuri first with G.S.Sachdev and then followed her passion to India and became a disciple of Pandit Hariprasad Chaurasia.
